DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conducts investigations and casework on criminal and civil cases; providing knowledge, expertise and experience for day to day operations and assist with more difficult investigations.....**55%**
- Provides 24-hours response to Attorney General in support of legal team.....**10%**
- Provides security for Attorney General's Office.....**25%**
- Participate/Partake in appropriate training/development programs to enhance/increase skills in specialized law enforcement, response, and investigation areas (cross-training).....**5%**
- Provide temporarily assistance and or supplement manpower for other divisions within the Bureau of Public Safety as required.....**5%**

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must be High School Graduate plus some training with at least one (1) year of work related experience. Must not have been convicted of felony or at least two misdemeanor crimes. Must speak and write palauan & english language.
- Must be twenty-one (21) years of age and above
- Must have received or attended some law enforcement training in addition to Basice Police Academy.
- Four (4) years on the job experience as a certified Law Enforcement Office and have performed at an acceptable level
- Position requires completion of the Physical Fitness Training Program, Police Academy and the Firearm Qualifications aspect of the National Law Enforcement Academy or similar structure
- Extrem confidentiality is required
- No felony convictions or more than two (2) misdemeanors in crime of violence, crimes involving dishonesty or moral turpitude in any jurisdiction.

- must undergo drug testing under the supervision of the Director, Bureau of Public Safety and if tested positive, will be required to take another test within five (5) working days, and if tested positive again, will be disqualified and will not be eligible to reapply for employment within the national government for a period of 3 years(see PNC33 §1203 (b) and §1205)
- And if employed and tested positive twice refer to PNC33 §1203 (b), §1204 (a & b); his/her name shall be forwarded to the Office of the Attorney General as stated in PNC33 §1207. Unwilling to cooperate with appropriate testing or provide relevant documents shall not be eligible.
- Must have a valid Palau's driver license.
