### **Faustina K. Rehuher-Marugg Swears in as Minister of State**

On June 13, Mrs. Faustina K. Rehuher-Marugg took her oath of office as the Minister of State and the newest member of President Tommy E. Remengesau, Jr.'s Cabinet.
