DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conduct periodic, routine and special inspections of all projects sites permitted by EQPB for compliance with work permit conditions/special conditions and environmental standards.
- Review permit applications and prepare recommendations for Compliance Supervisor as to the feasibility of applicants proposed project.
- Participate in the review of preliminary plans and specifications for public and private buildings and associated sewage and wastewater disposal systems, including inspections of government-owned sewage treatment systems and solid waste disposal sites.
- Conduct inspections of unpermitted sites discovered within the Republic. Investigate complaints of pollution or of other violations of Palau pollution control laws.
- Recommend appropriate actions to remedy identified violations; assist with the preparation and promulgation of Notice of Violation and Cease & Desist Order.
- Testify at Court or Board Hearings regarding project and violations.
- Coordinate inspection with other staff involved with the review and permitting process.
- Provide technical information to permit applicants in regards to installation of environmental quality controls.
- The Environmental Inspector shall gain and maintain a working knowledge of the EQPB Regulations and of environmental protection measures.
- Prepare written reports of all inspection activities based on accurate field observations detailing compliance or non-compliance with environmental laws, regulations and the terms and conditions of projects. Submit to supervisor and prepare follow-up information as requested.
- Perform other tasks as may be required by the EQPB Executive Officer and/ or the Compliance Supervisor.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Associate Degree with at least one (1) year of work related experience.
