DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist land surveyors in the measurement or determination of distance, evaluations, areas, angles, land boundaries, and other features of the earth's surface. Assist land surveyors in setting survey monuments. Surveying works requires highly proficient operation of instruments and application of techniques to obtain a require skill and accuracy. Surveying duties frequently include physically demanding tasks such as prolonged walking with heavy packs of instruments and equipment, clearing timber and undergrowth, and driving vehicles over rough terrain; to include very steep, wet, muddy, rough, uneven or rocky surfaces; positions require physical exertions such as bending, crouching, stooping stretching, reaching or similar activities. Individuals should be capable of working alone or with other people.....50%

- Responsible for basic maintenance of all surveying instrument and tools and performs other related duties as assigned.....25%
